7.1.12: CODE OF CONDUCT FOR STUDENTS:

The student code of conduct sets out the standards of conduct expected of students. It holds individuals and groups responsible for consequences of their actions. Institution takes pride in the responsibility of its students and the social and educational atmosphere of its campus. College students are held responsible for their conduct at all times. Any student who engages in academic or social misconduct shall be subject to student conduct action by Principal and staff. The college reserves the right to withdraw from any student the privilege of attending college for any lawful reason that the college deems appropriate. The following considerations constitute the foundation of the college's justification for establishing expectations of student conduct, codifying those expectations, and adopting equitable processes for assessing student conduct:

1. The college mission as a private residential educational institution establishes its identity as an independent community with a distinctive history and culture,
2. The rules and regulations of the college charge the faculty with responsibility for the welfare of the students and conditions they are to live and learn,
3. By the action matriculation and registration at college, students voluntarily enter an educational and residential community with academic honesty and respect for persons and property.
4. The students have the right to freedom of inquiry, expression, discussion etc,
5. Follow the discipline policy,
6. Students must strictly follow time management,
7. Be ambassadors for the college in the local area, be courteous and polite to members of the local community,
8. Respect the facilities, books and resources provided to assist in future studies,
9. Switch off phones and store them out of sight in class, unless by permission of the teacher,
10. Behave in a manner, within or outside college, that bring the college into disrepute,
11. Students must attend all registered sessions, unless ill or for other unavoidable reason, and be punctual, maintain attendance rate atleast 90%
12. Avoid chewing of gutka, tobacco etc,
13. ID card is compulsory for entering the college,
14. Students must respect faculty, staff, public, elders etc.

CODE OF CONDUCT FOR TEACHERS:

The code of Professional conduct for Teachers applies to all registered teachers. Its purpose is serves as a guiding compass as teachers seek to steer an ethical and respectful course through their career in teaching and to uphold the honour and dignity of the teaching profession. The role of Teaching council is to regulate the teaching profession and professional conduct of teachers, to establish and promote professional standards, to support the continuing professional development of teachers and to promote teaching as a profession. Keeping in mind it is expected that no teacher shall :

1. During the period of your service, you cannot join any college or pursue course of studies without the prior approval of the Head of Institution,
2. Leave cannot be claimed as a matter of right, when the exigencies of college service so require leave of any kind may be refused by the management,
3. While being present in the college, excusing him or her from the class which he or she required to attend,
4. Make any neglect in correcting classwork or homework done by the students,
5. All students must be treated equal,
6. All teachers are responsible for maintaining their Class Attendance Register, Daily Diary
7. Teachers must write books, publish the papers, attend professional development programs,
8. Mobile phones are strictly not permissible in the classrooms, labs and corridors,
9. Teachers must strictly follow Time Management,
10. Teachers must dedicate in improving the quality of teaching and properly guide and assist students to become good citizen of the nation,
11. Always teachers must actively participate in all most all college activities,
12. Teachers have right to contribute their knowledge for the development of college activities,
13. Treat all students with love and affection,
14. Makes planned and systematic efforts to facilitate the student to actualize his/her potential and talent,
15. Facilitates students physical, social, intellectual, emotional and moral development,
16. Transacts the curriculum in conformity with the values enshrined in the Constitution of India


